

United Club Scholarships can be awarded to a dependent of a U.S. Armed Forces service member, civilian component, or invited contractors as defined under the USA/ROF Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA) or U.S. military ID card holder and assigned to Camp Humphreys. Awardees must be enrolled or intend to enroll in an accredited academic institution on a part-time or full-time basis. Eligible academic programs must award a degree or certificate upon completion. To be eligible for the United Club merit scholarship, the applicant must meet one of the following conditions:

- 1. Be a graduating high school senior (graduate of 2022-2023 academic year). Applicants must plan to enroll or be enrolled at an accredited college, university, or vocational or trade school for the 2023-2024 school year.
- 2. Adult Continuing Education. Applicants must plan to continue working toward an undergraduate or graduate degree or certification for the 2023-2024 school year at an accredited college, university, or vocational or trade school.

Applications will be reviewed anonymously by a selection committee based on the applicant's academic record, job record, volunteer activity, participation in community-based activities, letters of recommendation, and a brief essay. The scholarship is merit-based; financial need is not taken into consideration.

Rules:

- Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Students who are homeschooled must submit their ACT/SAT scores. GED scores can be submitted in lieu of a GPA.
- Applicants who receive a "full-ride" scholarship (tuition, room, and board) or appointment to a service academy must withdraw their application and forfeit any United Club Scholarship award.

Scholarship recipients will be notified in April 2023 and invited to a United Club Scholarship Recognition event in May 2023.

Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the educational institution for deposit into the student's tuition account in accordance with the educational institution's scholarship process.

The completed application and all supporting documents must be submitted together, apart from the transcript, which may be mailed directly from the school. All material must be **received** by March 31, 2023, to be considered. **Handwritten applications, late or incomplete applications, or those missing any required documentation will not be considered.**

Scholarship Application Requirements/Checklist

- A cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher
- Completed 2023 Scholarship Application
- List of awards and dates
- Acceptance letter (if available) or verification of enrollment for college, university, or other vocational or trade program.
- Transcripts
 - High school transcripts for high school seniors and college freshmen
 - Most recent transcript for current undergraduate students.
 - Undergraduate and most recent graduate transcripts for graduate students.
 - Transcripts from off-peninsula applicants may be emailed directly from the school to the Scholarship Chair (scholarships@humphreysunited.org) and are subject to verification. It is understood that these transcripts may include the words "unofficial" once verification has been completed these transcripts will be accepted.
- At least one Letter of Recommendation from a non-relative written to the United Club describing the applicant's character and/or accomplishments.
- An essay with a minimum of a 500-word count (not to exceed 1000 words) addressing one of the topics provided.
